“BUILDING ON THE ROCK” CAPITAL CAMPAIGN UPDATE

Our 3-year capital campaign to raise \$750,000 for our Leadership Development Center is nearing the end. Now it's time to finish the “Victory Phase” of our campaign. Since January 1, 2002 we have raised a little more than half of our financial partnership goal. To date we have received \$156,267 from pledges, and \$247,915 in cash gifts for a total of \$404,182. We want to thank those of you who have already partnered with us and encourage others to join this great campaign.

We now have less than 4 months remaining on our original 3-year campaign and we need your help. In January, February, and March of 2005 we will be holding “Victory Team” banquet meetings in an area near you. The purpose of these meetings will be two-fold: first, to thank those of you who have already partnered with us in this project; and second, to encourage other churches and individuals to prayerfully consider making a financial commitment to this campaign. We will soon be sending invitations to individuals and churches to participate in these banquets, so please plan to attend and consider making a financial commitment to help us wrap up the “Victory Phase” of our campaign.
